

CSAA TENNIS TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- Players must check in 30 minutes prior to their scheduled match time.
- If a participant withdraws from any match they are disqualified for the entire tournament.
- Official forfeit time is 15 minutes from the original (or updated) scheduled start time.

Format: Jr./Sr. Divisions:

Front Draw - 8 Game Pro-set (no-ad scoring). If the score goes to 8-8, a 7-point tiebreaker (win by 2) will be played. Semi-Finals and Finals 2 out of 3 full sets (no-ad scoring). If sets are split a 10-point tiebreaker will be played (win by 2). 3rd-4th place matches will be the 8-game pro set format (no add scoring) with the 7-point tiebreaker on 8-8 (win by 2).

Back Draw/Consolation Bracket: 8 game pro set formats (No-Ad Scoring). Players will feed into this bracket up to and including the quarter finals. Players will feed into the back draw from the quarter finals.

The championship bracket will be for 1st through 4th place. The back draw/consolation bracket will play for 5th and 6th place.

Team Scoring System

Finals winner- 5 pts

Semi-finals winners and (3rd/4th place match winner) 4 pts

Quarter finals winners - 3 pts,

Round of 16 – 2 pts

Round of 32 or more- 1 pt

All back draw/consolation bracket wins – 1 pt

10 and under co-ed "Play Day" (USTA SPONSORED)

FORMAT: 10 AND UNDER – UP TO 25 INCH RACKETS, 60 FOOT COURT, ORANGE BALL, WITH SHORTENED SCORING.

COURT ETIQUETTE:

Players must always practice appropriate USTA recommended court etiquette.

Failure to do so could result in points taken away, forfeiture of game or games, or a match. The USTA official/CSAA official on-site will make any decisions necessary.
