- **MEET FORMAT**Session 1 1^{st} and 2^{nd} grade
Session 2 3^{rd} and 4^{th} grade
Session 3 $5^{th} 8^{th}$ grade
- **RULES** The meet will be conducted in accordance with the current NFHS Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where the rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated herein.
- **ENTRIES** Swimmers may enter in a maximum of one individual event and two relay events. Swimmers may be entered in individual and relay events in higher grades. **Kindergarten swimmers are not permitted in this meet.**

Entries must be submitted electronically using Hy-Tek Team Manager Lite or Meet Manager. Handwritten, telephone or fax entries will not be accepted. Team Manager Lite is downloadable free of charge from Hy-Tek's website at http://www.hy-tekItd.com/downloads.html

ENTRY DEADLINEElectronic entries must be emailed to Rich Flaherty no later than FEBRUARYFEBRUARY 23, 201723, 2017. No additional entries or changes will be accepted after February 23,

ENTRY TIMES Swimmers should be entered at their best short course yards time for individual events. Swimmers entered with no time (NT) will be seeded randomly in the early heats of an event. The fastest seed times will swim in the final heat. All events are timed-final.

Relays. Entry times are required for all A and B relays. All other relays should not have seed times and will be seeded randomly. Coaches are encouraged to list relay names on their electronic entries. Changes may be made up to the start of the race but must be noted on the relay cards and given to the head table.

- **RELAY CARDS** Relay teams will be given one relay card per team which should list all 4 swimmers on the relay (first and last names) in the correct order. All relay cards with any changes must be turned in to the head table at the designated time.
- **ENTRY FEES** \$11 per swimmer entered in the meet. Entry fees are due when entries are due and will be billed to the respective schools by the CSAA office.

- LANE MONITORS There will be NO CLERK OF COURSE. All teams are required to get their own swimmers to the starting area, including relays. Lane monitors will assist the swimmers in the starting area. Only designated representatives will be allowed on the pool deck to assist the swimmers with getting to the starting area.
- **COACHES MEETING THURSDAY, MARCH 2, 2017, 6:00pm RALPH WRIGHT NATATORIUM** Walk-thru before the meet. A coach from each team must attend. Coaches' passes, heat sheets, warm up assignments and other meet information will be distributed.
- **VOLUNTEERS** Each school will be required to provide volunteers to be either a lane monitor or safety marshal for each session. A worker sheet will be provided at the walk thru indicating the number of volunteers each school will need for each session. Volunteers will be called to the head table one-half hour before the start of each session.
- **SEATING CAPACITY** There is a seating capacity of 500 people at the Natatorium. There will be no reserved seats sold for the meet. Saving seats is not permitted. Athletes should stay on the deck in their team area and adults should stay in the stands. Due to limited seating, it is suggested that those wanting to attend this meet arrive early.
