To all AD's and Golf Coordinators,

The 2017 CSAA Golf Tournament for girls and boys will take place on Monday, June 5th at Seneca Golf Course.

2017 Mandatory on-line Registration: Each Parish Golf Coordinator or AD must fill out the official CSAA Golf Registration information on the CSAA web site (loucsaa.org) by May 15th. The registration template is located under the "golf ball" icon in the sports section of the CSAA web site. Please register each player separately and list each participant's average 9-hole score on the form. A separate form is also available to list each parish coach.

TIME: Tee times start at 8:00 AM
We will be teeing off hole #1 and #10 at 8:00 AM.
Everyone must arrive and register 30 minutes prior to the individual tee time. Late registration may mean disqualification.

PLACE: Seneca Golf Course

WHAT TO DO UPON ARRIVAL: Check in at the CSAA desk/table and confirm your tee time.

FEES: The CSAA golf fee is \$22.00 per participant. This covers greens fees and a CSAA fee. Each parish will be invoiced by the CSAA office for the total number of registered players.

TEAMS: The top three individual scores will determine the winning parish. If you don't have three golfers for a team, they may compete as individuals only.

REMINDER: Parishes may not merge together to form a team. They can practice together but must play for their own parish. The CSAA does not allow consolidation of parishes for individual sports.

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS: 3rd graders through 8th graders only. (No K, 1st or 2nd graders are eligible to participate).

2017 COURSE SET UP: 7TH & 8TH boys - back 9/gold tee's
7th & 8th girls - back 9/red tee's
5th & 6th boys – front 9/red tee's
5th & 6th girls – front 9/red tee's
3rd & 4th boys and girls – back 9/shorter red tee's (8 holes only, no #16)

PACE OF PLAY: This CSAA Golf Tournament is not a clinic for beginners. Each player must keep pace with the other players in their group. Prior experience playing golf on a regulation golf course is necessary.

AWARDS: 1st and 2nd place team trophies will be awarded in the 5th & 6th and the 7th & 8th grade division (Note the change from past years). 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place individual awards will be given out in the 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th grade level.

TIE BREAKER: Score cards will be used to break ties for teams and individuals. The tie breaker will be determined from the score card using a hole from the front side and/or the back side. This hole will be selected by the course professional or his designee prior to the tournament.

* Each foursome that goes on the course will be responsible for another person's score in the group.

* No parental involvement is allowed on the course at any time to maintain the integrity of the tournament format.

* **Range finders and GPS yardage/distance/slope measuring devices will be allowed.**

The Head Professional or his/her designee will be the rules judge in this tournament and his/her decisions are final. Please be respectful of all course rules and regulations. Improper behavior or unethical conduct will not be tolerated. The CSAA appreciates the opportunity to utilize Seneca Golf Course and requires all participants to be respectful at all times.
