To all AD's and Golf Coordinators,

The 2015 CSAA Golf Tournament for girls and boys will take place on Wednesday June 3rd at Seneca Golf Course. The format this year for all divisions will be 9 holes and everyone will compete on the same day.

DATE: Wednesday, June 3rd.

TIME: Tee times start at 8:00 AM
We will be teeing off hole #1 and #10 at 8:00 AM.
Everyone must arrive and register 30 minutes prior to the individual tee time. Late registration may mean disqualification.

PLACE: Seneca Golf Course

WHAT TO DO UPON ARRIVAL:

Check in at the CSAA desk/table and confirm your tee time.

FEES: The CSAA fee is \$11.00 per participant. Current Jr greens fees at Seneca Golf Course are \$9.25. The CSAA fee is separate from the greens fee and **each parish will be invoiced \$20.25 per participant for the total number of registered players.** Cash/checks will no longer be accepted at the site for CSAA fee payment.

TEAMS: The top three finishing individual scores will determine the winning parish. If you don't have three golfers for a team, they may compete as individuals only.

REMINDER: Parishes may not merge together to form a team. They can practice together but must play for their own parish. The CSAA does not allow consolidation of parishes for individual sports.

AWARDS: 1st and 2nd place team trophies will be awarded to each grade level (5th, 6th, 7th and 8th).
1st, 2nd, and 3rd place individual awards will be given out in the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th grade Divisions.

TIE BREAKER: Score cards will be used to break ties for teams and individuals. Awards will only be given to the top 3 teams and the top 4 individuals after the tie breaker. The tie breaker will be determined from the score card using a hole from the front side and/ or the back side. This hole will be selected by the course professional or his designee prior to the tournament.

- * Each foursome that goes on the course will be responsible for another person's scores in the group.
- * No personal coolers allowed on the course.
- * No beginners. This CSAA event is tournament format and not a clinic.

****** Range finders and GPS yardage/distance/slope measuring devices will be allowed. ******

The current Head Professional or his/her designee will be the rules judge in this tournament and his/her decisions are final. Please be respectful of all course rules and regulations at all times. Improper behavior or unethical conduct will not be tolerated at any time. The CSAA appreciates the opportunity to utilize this facility and requires all participants to be respectful to all involved at all times.
