Dear Sixth Grade Parents,

Saint Leonard is taking your sixth grade student into the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. Through several years of research, a helpful technology committee, a dedicated computer teacher, several grants received and lots of hard work, our students will be preparing for new educational and technology experiences.

Saint Leonard's 1:1 Program will include sixth, seventh and eighth grade students (roll out will take three years beginning this year with the sixth grade). This year, students will receive a Dell Latitude 10 tablet which will be available for their use 24/7 by that student for the three years in middle school. Students will incorporate technology throughout the curriculum to enhance learning. Each student will be able to use these devices to take notes, access internet resources, podcasts, check headlines of current events, refer to web based textbooks and much more.

Students of Saint Leonard will be able to take on the challenges of high school and the world in which they will work and the companies that they run.

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The school will lease a device to each student for \$25 per month, for ten months a year, for three years. When your student has met all requirements and is ready to graduate, the school will sell the device to that same student for \$1.

Program leasing fees include, but are not limited to the following: Standard software image including operating system (Windows 8), GoogleApps, DyKnow Program, web browser, antivirus software, multimedia software, specialized curricula related software, access to network applications and services, warranty, on-campus technical support and repair services and loaner laptops for extended repairs.
